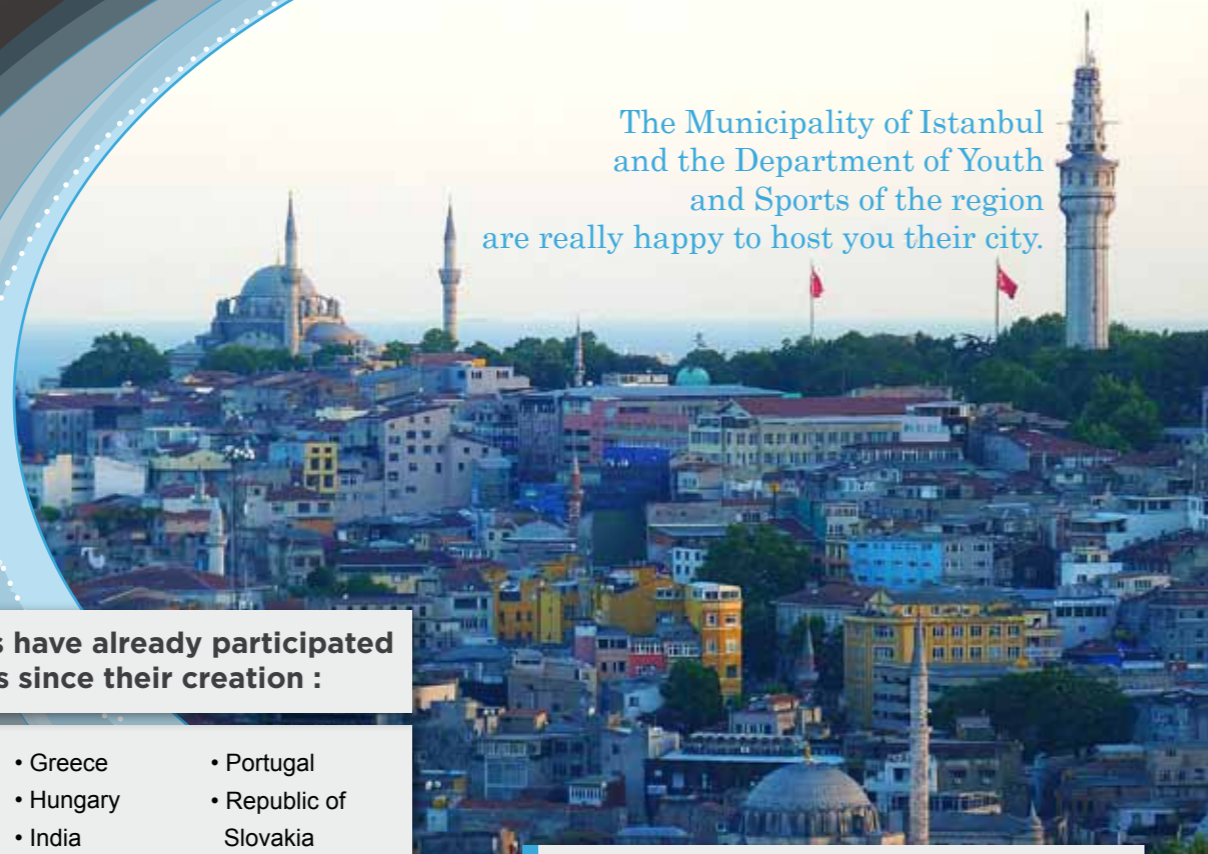

>>> THE MEDIGAMES, A MAJOR EVENT FOR ISTANBUL, THE UPCOMING EUROPEAN CAPITAL OF SPORTS

The announcement was made on 13 August 2011 by the Turkish Prime Minister, Recep Tayyip Erdogan : « **The Turkish metropolis is once again a candidate for the 2020 Olympic Games** ». The Istanbulites have a passion for sports. In addition, the city annually hosts many sporting events such as the F1 Turkish Grand Prix on its Istanbul Park circuit (since 2005), the final of the Champions League in 2005, the European short course swimming Championships in 2009 and the World Basketball Championships in 2010. The athletic events are held by age groups. The reference date taken into account is the date on which the Games are opened, 07 July 7, 2012.

A – under 35

(born after 07/07/77)

B – from 35 to 44

(born between 08/07/67 and 07/07/77)

C – from 45 to 54

(born between 08/07/57 and 07/07/67)

D – from 55 to 64

(born between 08/07/47 and 07/07/57)

E – 65 and over

(born before 08/07/47)

There is no age category for team sports, golf and chess.

>> The awards

For each category, the first 3 will receive gold, silver and bronze medals.

In team sports, a cup is also awarded to the winner.

Each evening the medal winners of the day will be honored.

The participants families and friends may participate in the events open to them according to the terms specified in the sporting sheet. In order to preserve the WMHG spirit they will not be classified with the same title as the actual participants and will not receive medals for their performances.

>> Checks

All athletes, except for those who participated in 2011 (and whose credentials were checked at that time) will have to present a professional certificate along with a medical certificate no older than 1 year authorizing the practice of their chosen sports. Failure to produce both documents will result in the denial of badges. Moreover, in case of any doubt regarding a document, CSO reserves the right to refuse access to the Games to the document holder.

Thank you in advance for your understanding.

CSO has faith in the authenticity of the documents presented by the participants and will not be held responsible in case of fraud or falsification of these certificates. However, in case of proven fraud, CSO will sanction the wrongdoer.

>>> Istanbul, wonder of the World

Straddling two continents (Europe and Asia), Istanbul is a city full of surprises. Steeped in history and listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO since 1985, this ancient city offers a unique setting, is a haven of taste and is filled with special monuments and places. Its geographical position has made it a mythical place where tourism is growing rapidly. In 2008, Istanbul hosted more than a quarter of the 26 million tourists that came to discover Turkey.

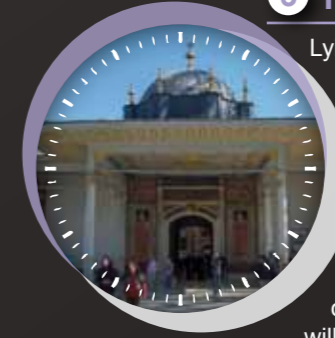
Cultural Capital of Europe in 2010, Istanbul is full of historical sites and monuments to visit such as the Hagia Sophia, the Blue Mosque, the Topkapi Palace, Dolmabahçe Palace, Süleymaniye Mosque and the Grand Bazaar.

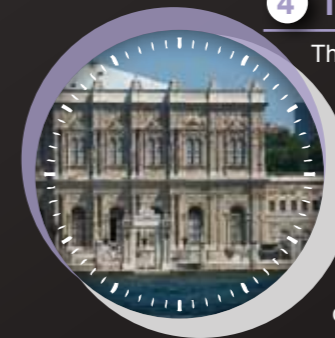
2 The Hagia Sophia

Since its opening in 537, this fifteen century old building has undergone numerous renovations and was converted into a mosque after Constantinople was conquered in 1453. Discover its fabulous interior with its famous mosaics over their gold backgrounds, its wonderful columns and dome roofing, all of immense artistic value. Over the years many valuable or miraculous objects have come to enrich the fabulous treasure of the Basilica.



3 Topkapi Palace

Lying on a surface of 700,000m² and surrounded by 5km of walls, the legendary Topkapi palace is an architectural complex consisting of four main courtyards and numerous adjoining buildings. Defined to be « a city within a city », the Topkapi palace was the main residence of the sultan and his court; it was also the official seat of government. Located on the « Seraglio Point » (an area in which most of the Mosques are concentrated) overlooking the Sea of Marmara, the Topkapi Palace hides a treasure that will plunge you into Istanbul's Imperial History.



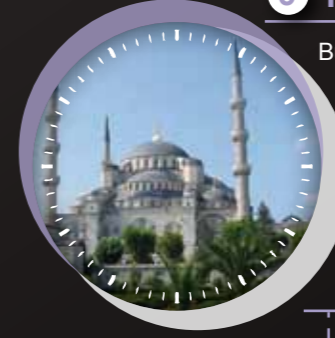
4 The Dolmabahçe Palace

The Dolmabahçe palace is managed by the Directorate of the National Palace and under the responsibility of the Grand National Assembly of Turkey. It is the largest palace in the country. Its decoration mainly mirrors the western model with baroque, rococo and neoclassical notions. It is a mixture of genres that makes it unique. Among the wonders to discover, you will find the largest Bohemian crystal chandelier in the world hanging in the middle of the ceremonial room.



6 The Blue Mosque

Built between 1609 and 1616, the Blue Mosque is one of the most popular tourist attractions of Istanbul. The beautiful blue mosaics that cover the interior walls are famous throughout the world. The glass that decorates the windows in the back of the mosque is covered with floral motifs. They make the blue mosque one of the most beautiful places of worship in the Muslim world.



5 The Süleymaniye Mosque

Built between 1550 and 1557, the Süleymaniye mosque is undoubtedly considered the most beautiful of the imperial mosques in Istanbul. Every detail makes it unique. Its prayer room is very spacious but you will be surprised by its incredible brightness. The gardens surrounding the building are well maintained and offer a pleasant stroll and view over the Bosphorus. Built on a hill in the western part of Istanbul, in the Golden Horn, it dominates the city.



1 The Grand Bazaar

Uncommon amongst the people of Istanbul, it is a favorite spot amongst tourists coming to Istanbul. The Grand Bazaar immerses you in the middle of 4300 shops located in a maze of narrow streets and vaulted alleys. The architecture alone is worth seeing. Dive into an oriental atmosphere to bring back some colorful souvenirs from Istanbul. For food lovers, discover the incredible area of the Grand Bazaar dedicated to spices (the Egyptian bazaar).

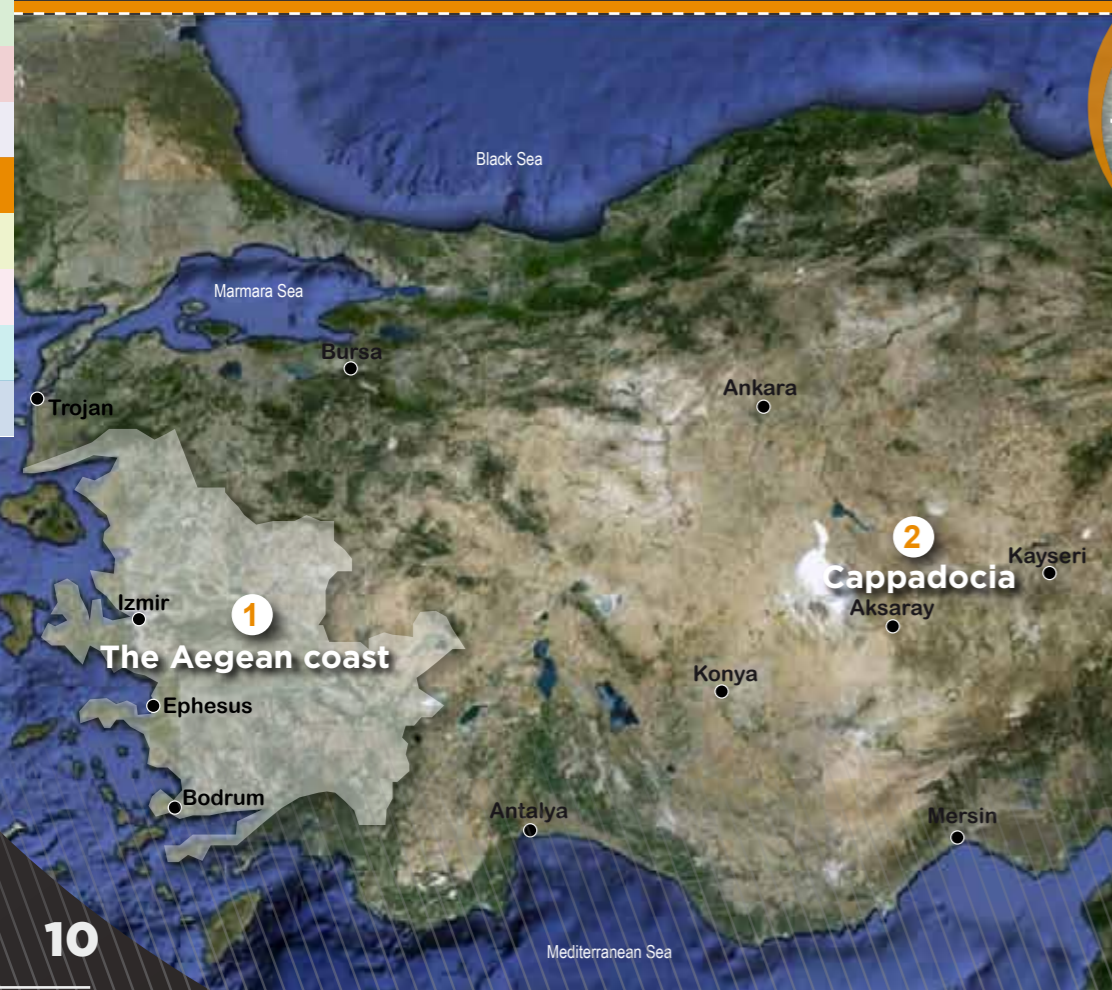
>>> Turkey, a dazzling diversity

The sunny Mediterranean climate will make your excursions even more pleasurable, ideal for your vacation.

Turkey has the richest historical heritage in the entire Mediterranean region. Lapped by four seas, Turkey offers its visitors the charm of its enchanting beaches. Discover its historical and archaeological sites and its artistic treasures while traveling through its **stunningly diverse landscapes** rich with flora and fauna.

Everyone can create their own program according to their interests. In Western Turkey, you can visit the archaeological sites of the Aegean coast that give a glimpse of the region's Greek and Roman past. On the other hand, the eastern region will be of interest to visitors who want to learn about historical Armenia, but also for those who want to discover the remains of the Uratu kingdom.

Throughout your stay you will notice that the Turks have a profound sense of hierarchy and respect. If the Turks throw a little bit of water behind your car as you leave, it's a way to tell you :
« We hope that God will protect you and that you will return soon! ».
The Turks are very welcoming and offer unforgettable hospitality and generosity.



1 The Aegean coast

The Aegean coast is the ideal region for many activities : the beach and its water sports for relaxation and the discovery of ancient ruins for culture (Ephesus, Miletus, Aphrodisias, Pamukkale, etc...).
The Aegean generous climate is conducive to visiting the ancient sites that line its coast and visitors can delve into the region's rich history of colonization by the Greeks and Romans.
During your exploration of the Aegean coast, we advise you to visit the great city of Ephesus.



2 Cappadocia

A region of 15,000km² between Kayseri and Aksaray that is generally known by the name Cappadocia. Situated in central Turkey, Cappadocia is full of surprises. Its landscape is covered with **astounding volcanic formations**. The rock cones, **called fairy chimneys**, were sculpted by the wind and by water runoffs over thousands of years.

A long process that led to a **lunar landscape**, more than 1000m above sea level, that attracts tourists from around the world.

It is also for its **magnificent churches**, decorated with colorful frescoes, that people come to visit Cappadocia. They have left us with a **superb example of Byzantine art**. The best way to discover them is by walking in the rich valleys of Cappadocia, the most famous of which is the Göreme valley.
Another surprise : the valleys of the region contain underground cities. In ancient times the residents dug dwellings within the rock in order to disappear from the surface of the earth as a refuge from attacks and invasions. The many paths crisscrossing the Cappadocia will delight **hiking enthusiasts**.

Facts worth knowing

Population : Approximately 77 million inhabitants. The main cities are Istanbul, Ankara (the capital city), Izmir, Adana, Antalya, Bursa, Gaziantep, Denizli and Diyarbakir.

Religion : The majority of the Turkish population is Muslim. The state is secular and there is absolute religious freedom.

Politics : The Turkish republic is a secular democracy with a pluralist parliamentary system.

Ephesus

Ephesus is one of the oldest and most important Greek cities of Asia. While visiting Ephesus, you will experience the past and discover the history of the roman period. It is a vast archaeological site displaying beautiful remains of several civilizations.
Bordered by its three hills, the city is a collection of wonders of the world. The ruins, with their considerable reputation, are from the 1st century B.C.
Ephesus is home to several religions but, especially, it was the host of Christianity for more than a millennium and was also an important center for the pagan world. The Virgin Mary is now a popular place of pilgrimage for Christians and Muslims. Discovered by archaeologists in the XIXth century, the stone house was the last home of the Virgin Mary before her death. Located 18km from the seaside resort of Kusadasi, Ephesus is a city full of surprises.

Kusadasi

Kusadasi, or the island of birds, was a small fishing village and is now one of Turkey's most famous seaside resorts. Despite the fact that Kusadasi is a «new town», here you will find the country's most important archaeological sites.

Philippe Sella, president of the association is a former rugby player and was considered one of the best center three-quarters in the world for nearly a decade. In 2010, he was the coach of the under-20 French team and asserts the values divulged by the Rugby Union.

This admiration has led to **fundamental principles : enthusiasm, commitment, solidarity, audacity, courage, risk taking...** Philippe and his close friends had the idea to create « **Les enfants de l'Ovale** ».
